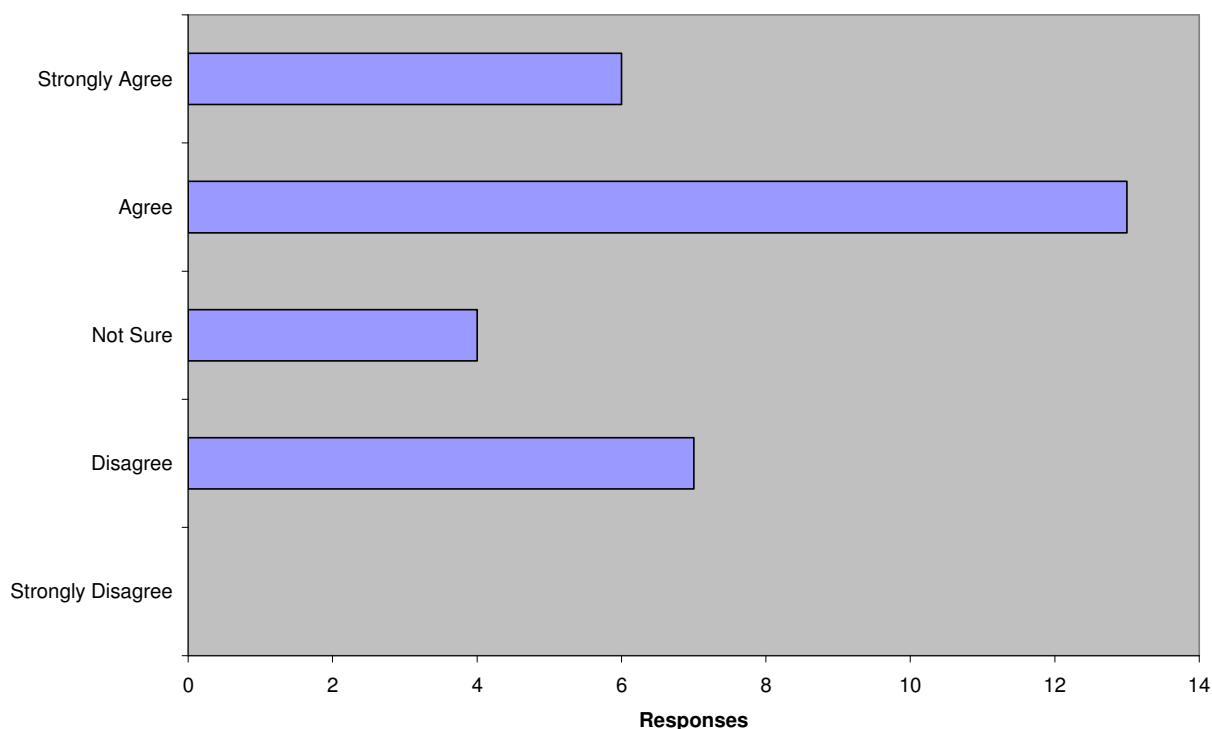


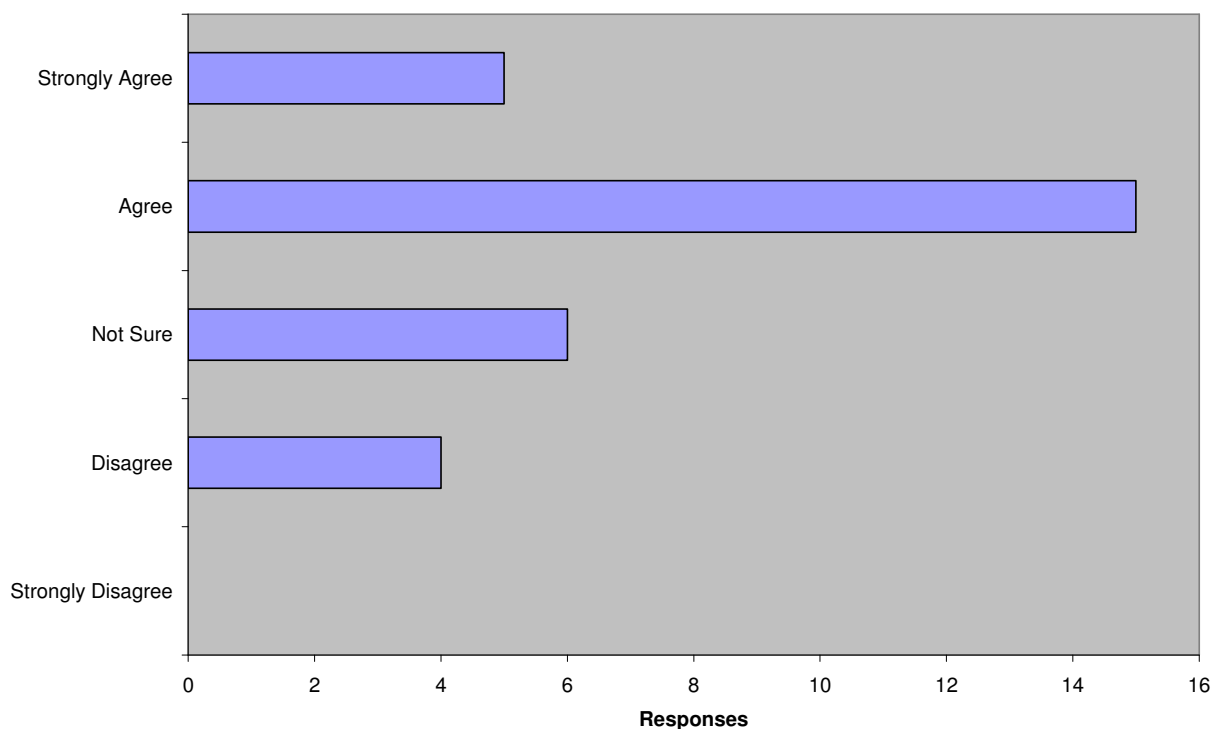

1. The Hampshire Home Choice process for applying for properties is easy to understand



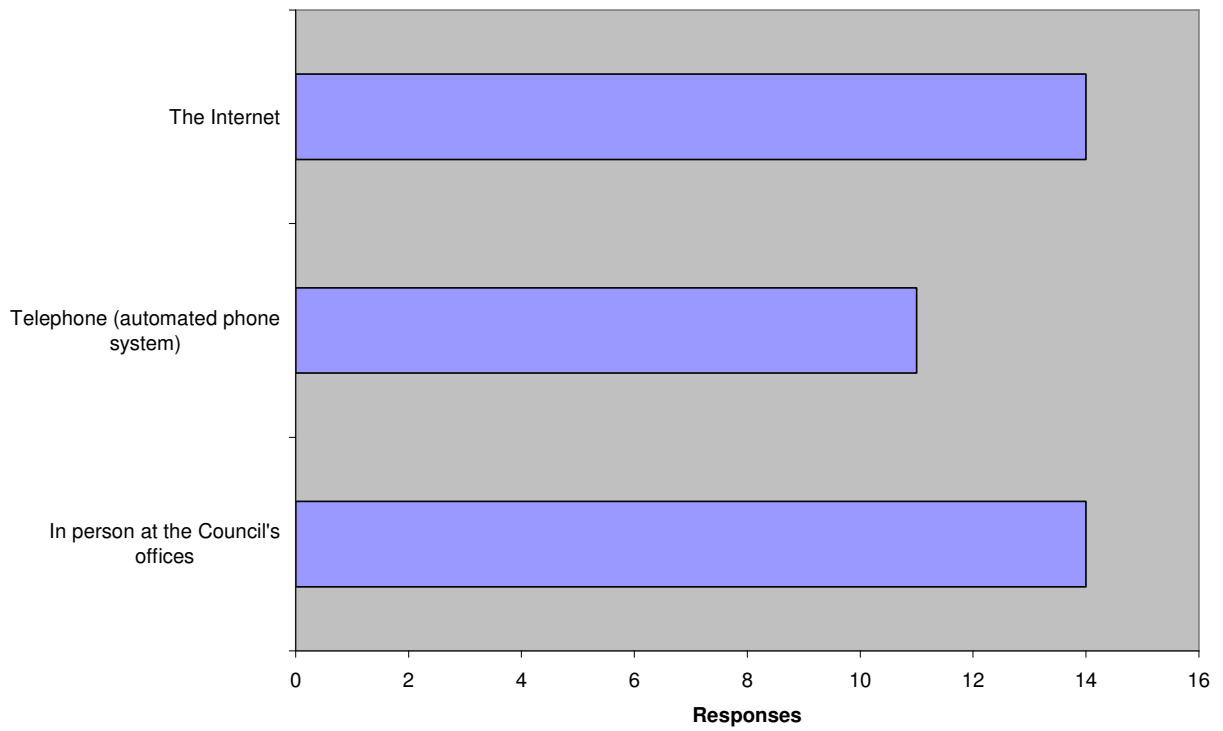
2. Hampshire Home Choice will make it easier for applicants to select where they wish to live



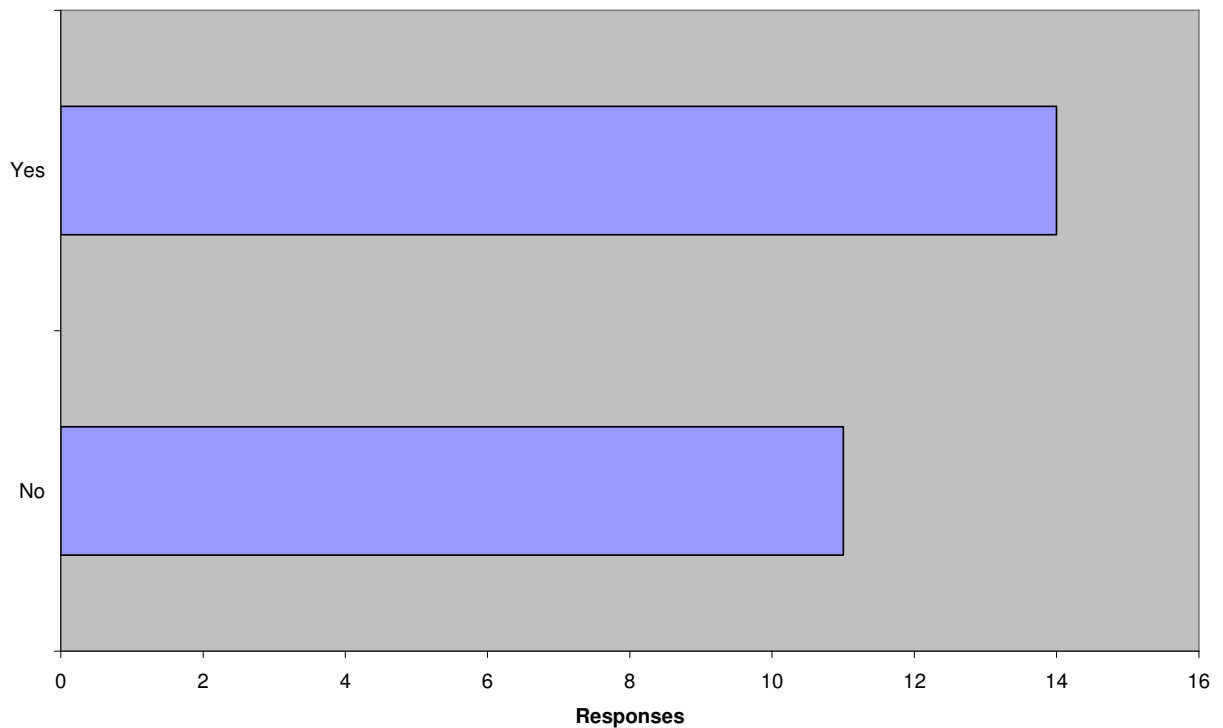
3. Where would you most like to see vacant property adverts?

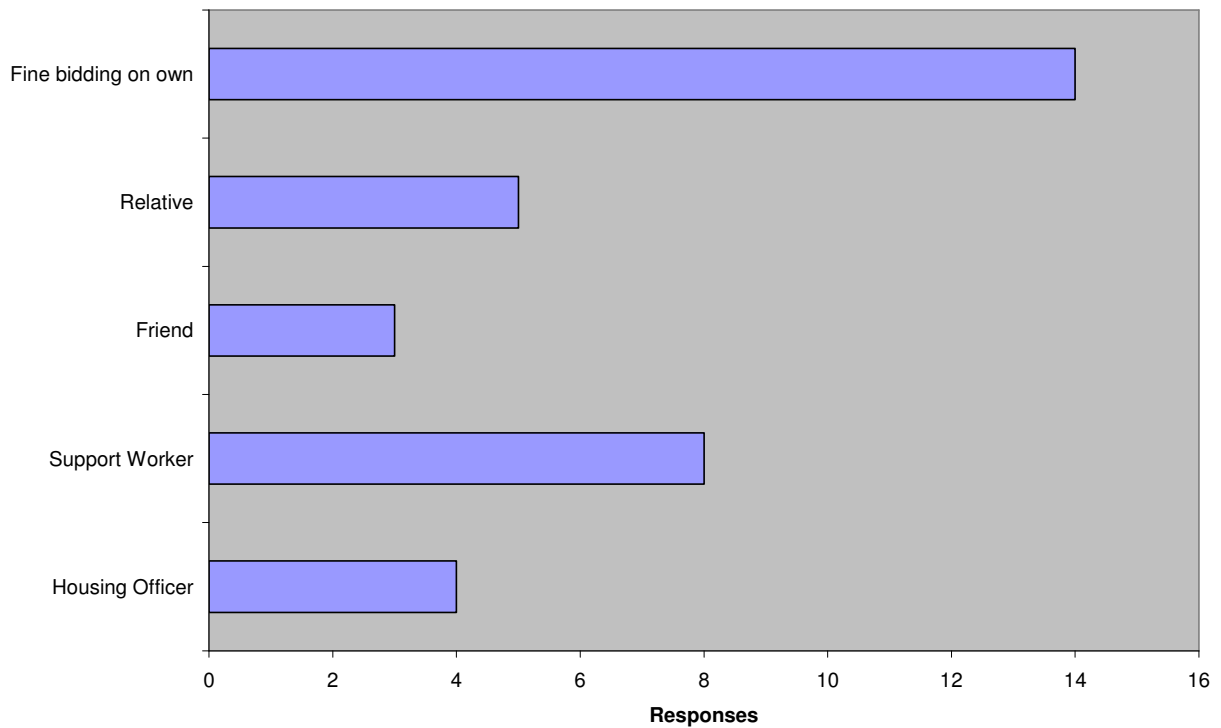
4. Which method of bidding for a property (expressing an interest) do you think you are most likely to use?



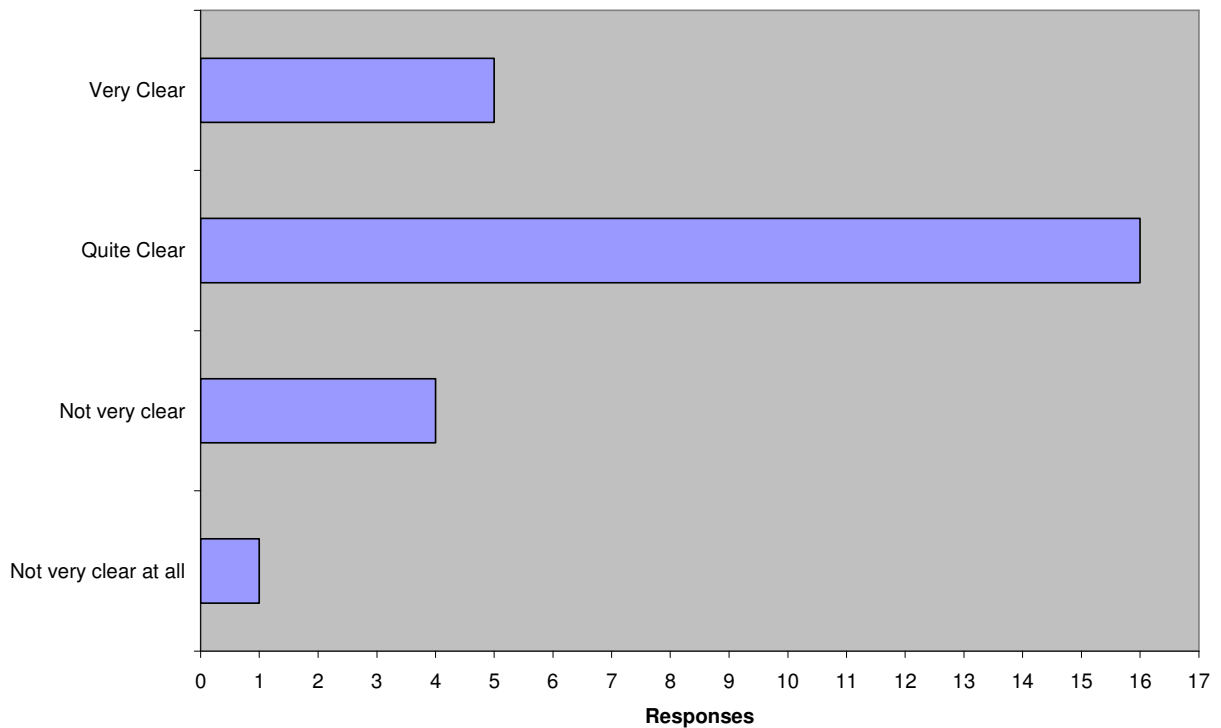
5. Do you have access to the internet either at home or in a nearby local facility, e.g. library or local Council Office?
