

What is Park & Ride?

Winchester Park and Ride is the cheapest and greenest way to park in Winchester for all commuters, visitors or shoppers.

Frequent and efficient buses serve all Park & Ride car parks, the railway station, hospital and Winchester City Centre along with many other destinations, see map overleaf.

Park & Ride bus stops are easily recognisable – Look for the bus stops with the P&R logo.

Facilities

There are three car parks off the M3 providing:

- 780 spaces at Barfield & St Catherine's, junction 10
- 864 spaces at South Winchester, junction 11.

The car parks are monitored by CCTV and two have been awarded Park Mark safer parking status for security and safety. South Winchester is being built to Park Mark standards.

The ticket machines are Pay & Display however they also accept Smart Cards that offer discounted parking for regular users. Smart Cards can be purchased from Winchester City Council Parking Office.

The St. Catherine's and South Winchester site includes visitor information, toilets, and help points.

Low floor buses are used on the park and ride service to provide better accessibility.

Pay to park, free to ride!

- 10% discount with smart card
- Annual season ticket with 20% discount
- NEW Off Peak weekday rate after 10:30am (cheaper than parking in town!)

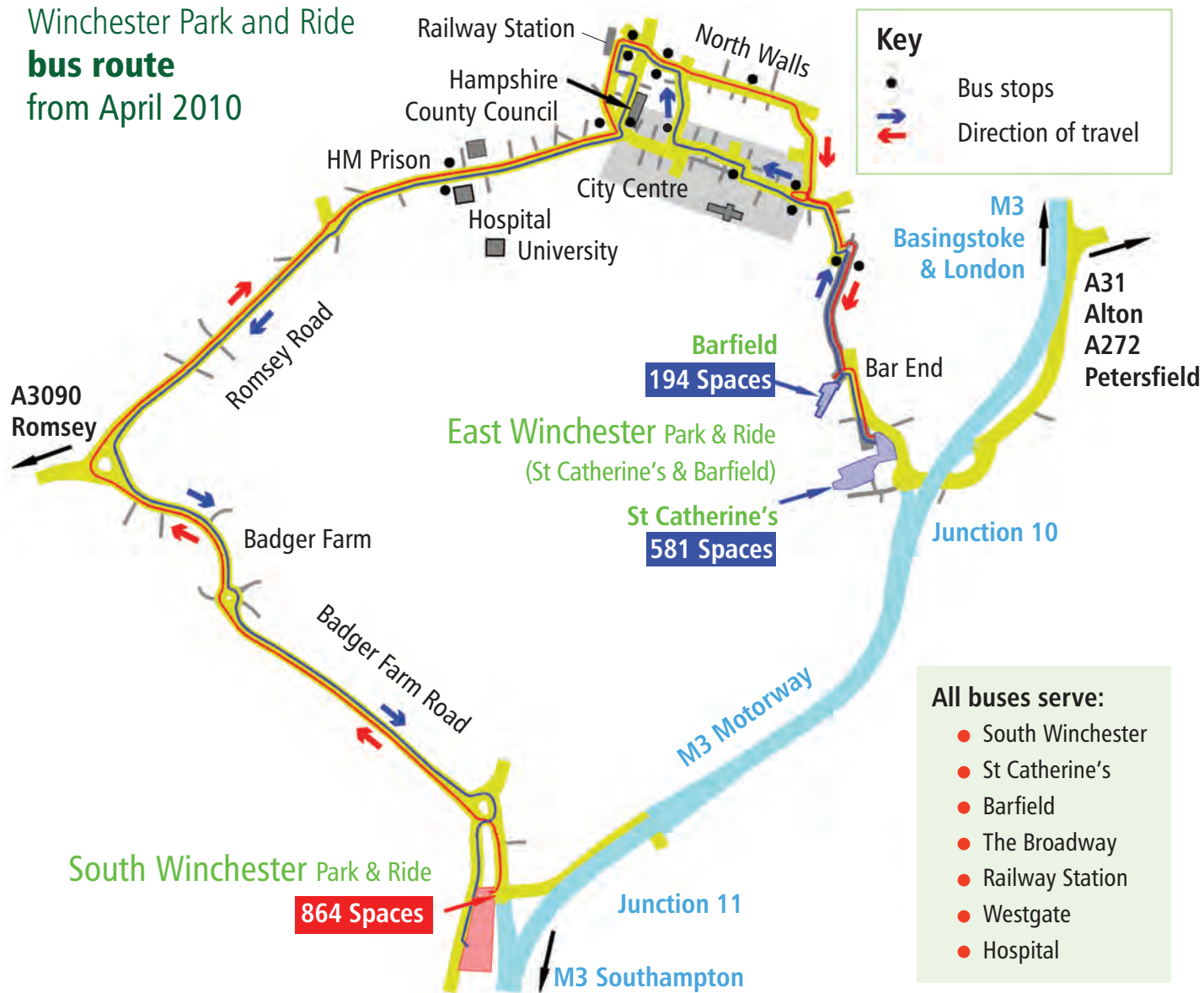
