Facilities

There are two car parks, providing approximately 780 spaces at Bar End, near the M3 at junction 10.

The car parks are monitored by CCTV and have been awarded "Secured car park" status for security and safety. The ticket

machines are Pay & Display however they also accept Smart Cards that offer discounted parking for regular users. Smart Cards can be purchased from Winchester City Council Parking Office.

The St. Catherine's site includes visitor information, toilets, and help points.

Low floor buses are used on the park and ride service to provide better accessibility.

Bus Routes

Buses provide a frequent service to all the main areas of Winchester city centre, including the shopping area, law courts, visitor attractions, county and city council offices, and the railway station. Buses stop at all green bus stops, look for the Park and Ride logo.

Operating times

Monday - Friday 7:15am till 6:30pm

Saturdays 7:30am till 6:00pm

during peak periods buses run every 8 minutes (15 minutes off peak).

On Saturdays buses run every 10 minutes.

Journey times, subject to traffic conditions are; to the Broadway (Bus Station) 8 mins to the Railway Station 15 mins.

No Park and Ride service operates on a Sunday or Public Holidays.

Environmental Benefits

Winchester City Council and Hampshire County Council are involved with a number of projects aimed at improving the city environment. The **Winchester Movement and Action Plan (WMAAP)** aims to reduce traffic volumes and improve air quality in the city centre. This is supported by the **MIRACLES** project. **MIRACLES** is part of the wider **CIVITAS** initiative, which brings together 19 European cities, all committed to sustainable urban transport policy strategies.

The overall aim of **CIVITAS** is to achieve a significant change in the modal split towards sustainable transport modes. Park and Ride has been developed as a way of reducing traffic volume and as a consequence improving air quality and reducing the impact of traffic in the city centre.

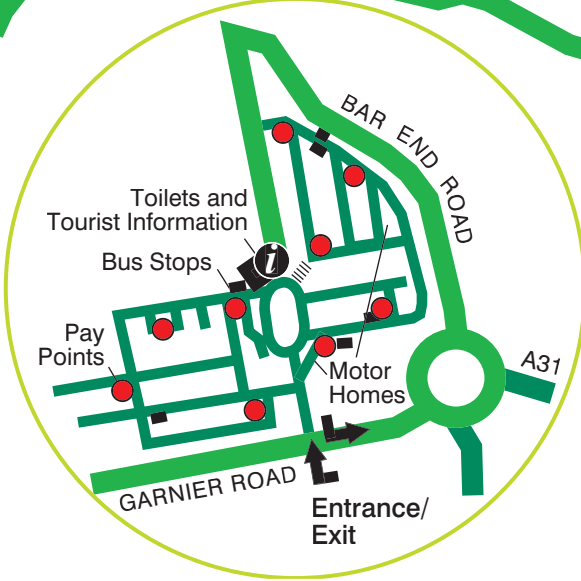
