

Ordnance Survey copyright

Under S107 of the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 all maps and plans supplied as part of a planning application must carry a valid Ordnance Survey License Number and OS Copyright Note, the license having been issued by the Ordnance Survey and allowing the applicant/agent to use Ordnance Survey derived information.

These details must be included, otherwise your application will NOT be accepted by the Council and will be classed as being INVALID.
(Your application will remain invalid until the information is received)

NON-COMPLIANCE WITH ORDNANCE SURVEY COPYRIGHT CAN ALSO LEAD TO LEGAL PROCEEDINGS AND A FINE
