# **SUMMARY**

- It is proposed to introduce 'no waiting at any time' restrictions in Fromond Road, Trussell Crescent and Taplings Road, Winchester due to continued inconsiderate parking on the grass central reserves.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.
- One letter of objection was received.

- The cost of the proposal will be funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There are no significant additional enforcement costs.


