SUMMARY

The allocation of grants from the Small Grants Funding scheme which includes Biodiversity, Carbon Reduction, Community Chest, Community Planning, and Twinning, from the approved budget.

PROPOSED DECISION

1. It is recommended that the following grant be awarded from the **Community Chest scheme** (please note that, due to the number of applications received and the total amount of grant requested, not all groups have been awarded the full amount requested):

Sparsholt Memorial Hall Management Committee

Amount Requested: £500 Amount Awarded: £400 Funding is recommended towards the purchase of 100 chairs in order to expand the educational and recreational programmes at the hall. The existing plastic chairs will be retained for outdoor events and 'messy' activities. The request was not fully awarded as it was felt reasonable to expect the group to put some of their own funding towards this cost, particularly in view of the number of applications received and the total amount of grant requested in this round.

REASON FOR THE PROPOSED DECISION AND OTHER ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

Grants from the Small Grants Scheme are made four times per year. All applications for grants were considered by the relevant Portfolio Holder who received advice from the Partnership and External Funding Officer and other relevant officers as appropriate.

This application was considered in October alongside the small grants included in PHD176. However details of this application were omitted from that Portfolio Holder Decision Notice.
