PROPOSED TRAFFIC ORDER TO INTRODUCE ONE WAY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS IN TRUSSELL CRESCENT WINCHESTER

Winchester City Council on behalf of Hampshire County Council propose making a traffic regulation order as follows :-

<u>EFFECT OF ORDER</u>: To introduce a one way traffic restriction in Trussell Crescent, Winchester.
