- It is proposed to introduce 'No waiting at any time' waiting restrictions in Trussell Crescent and Fromond Road, Winchester at their southern junction to provide better visibility at the exit of Trussell Crescent onto Fromond Road with the introduction of one-way traffic in Trussell Crescent.
- The revision has been requested by residents following road safety and emergency services and other access concerns.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management and road safety.
- No objections to the proposal as advertised were received.

# STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR REVISION:-

To introduce traffic management measures to alleviate road safety.

Winchester City Council on behalf of Hampshire County Council propose making a traffic regulation order as follows:-

<u>EFFECT OF ORDER:</u> To introduce a "no waiting at any time" restriction at the junction of Fromond Road and Trussell Crescent, Winchester. Details of the areas affected are as under.

#### No Waiting at any Time

Road Name	<u>Side</u>	<u>Description</u>
Trussell Crescent	North- west	Between its southern junction with Fromond Road and a point 8.0 metres east of that junction.
Trussell Crescent	South- west	Between its southern junction with Fromond Road and a point 8.0 metres east of that junction.
Fromond Road	North- east	Between its southern junction with Trussell Crescent and a point 10.0 metres north of that junction.
Fromond Road	North- east	Between its southern junction with Trussell Crescent and a point 6.0 metres south of that junction.

<u>FURTHER DETAILS</u>: a copy of this notice, the proposed order, a map showing the location and effect of the proposal, a statement of reasons and the order to be varied may be inspected during usual office hours at the following place:-

(i) City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

<u>OBJECTIONS:</u> All objections and other representations in respect of this proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2006. All objections must state the grounds on which they are made.

<u>TITLE:</u> The order, if made will be known as "The Hampshire (Various Roads, Winchester) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) (No 2) 2001 (Variation No.10) Order 2006.
