<u>TOPIC – PROPOSED INTRODUCTION OF TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER – BARFIELD CLOSE, WINCHESTER</u>

SUMMARY

- It is proposed to introduce a traffic regulation order prohibiting motor vehicles except buses between 7:00am and 10:00am in Barfield Close, Winchester between its junction with Chesil Street and a point 40 metres east of that junction in a westerly direction, to provide clear access for the park and ride buses during peak hours.
- The revision is required to make the existing restrictions as signed enforceable and is a condition of the adoption process for Barfiled Close to become a public adopted highway.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management.
- No objections to the proposal as advertised were received.

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- The cost of the proposal will be funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There will be no additional enforcement costs.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR REVISION:-

To introduce traffic management measures to provide priority for buses during morning peak hour periods.

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BARFIELD CLOSE WINCHESTER

Winchester City Council on behalf of Hampshire County Council propose making a traffic regulation order as follows:-

<u>EFFECT OF ORDER:</u> To introduce a prohibition of motor vehicles except buses between 7.00am and 10.00am in Barfield Close, Winchester.

Description of road

Permitted traffic flow (Buses Only)

Barfield Close between its junction with Chesil Street and a point 40 metres east of that junction

Westerly
