### **TOPIC – PROPOSED REVISION TO TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER – MIDDLE BROOK STREET, WINCHESTER**

#### **SUMMARY**

- It is proposed to revise the existing traffic regulation order in relation to waiting restrictions in Middle Brook Street, Winchester from the existing restriction of 'Permit holders only 8:00am to 6:00pm' to 'Permit holders only 8:00am to 10:00pm' and to extend the bays. It is also proposed to introduce 'No waiting at any time' waiting restrictions in some lengths of Middle Brook Street to provide clear access to properties.
- The revision has been requested by residents due to difficulties in parking in the evenings caused by visitors to the various evening venues in the city and following the reversal of traffic flow in Parchment Street.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve the environment and on road safety and traffic management grounds.

- No objections to the proposal as advertised were received.
- The cost of the proposal will be funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There will be no additional enforcement costs.

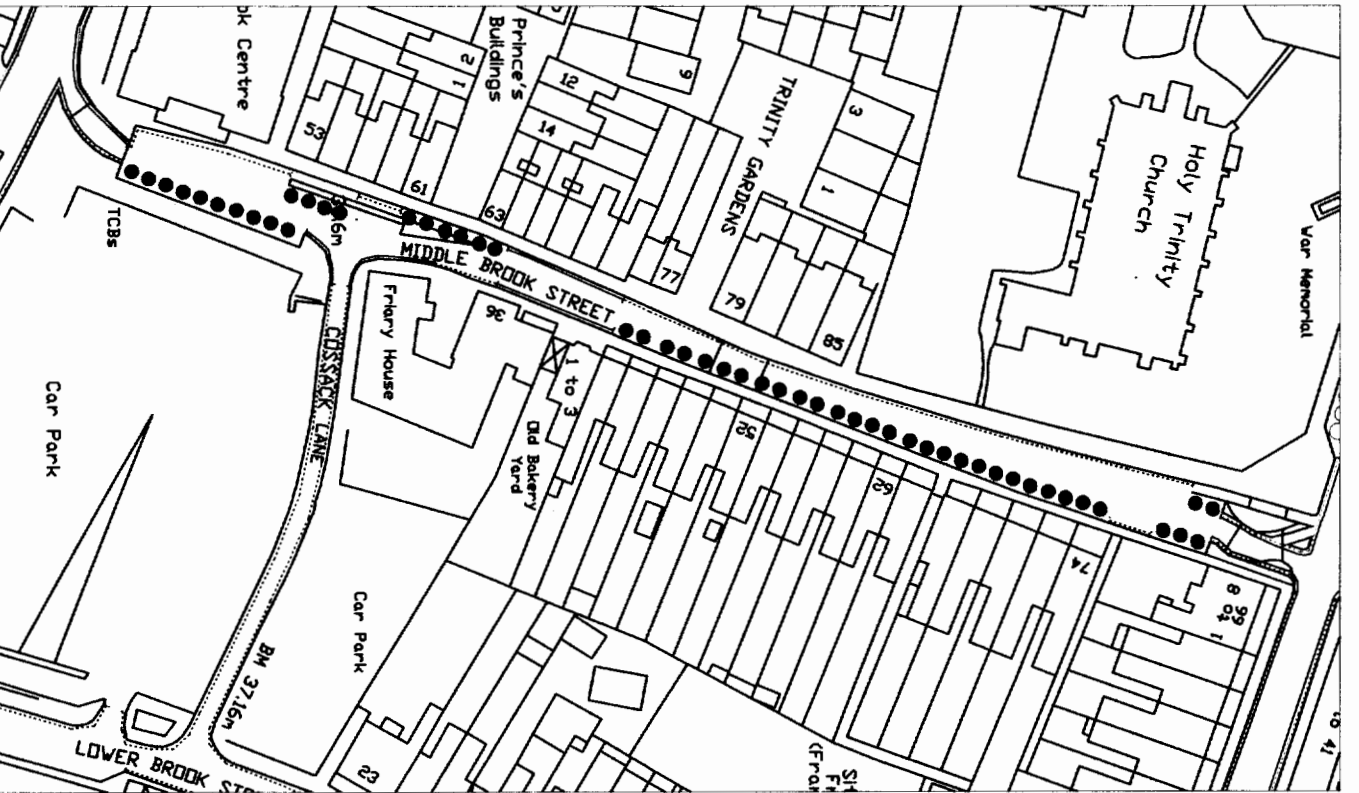
