STATEMENT OF REASONS:-

The scheme is being proposed on traffic management and road safety grounds to prevent obstructive parking of vehicles which hinders the turning movements of large vehicles and buses.

PROPOSED NEW TRAFFIC ORDER TO APPLY WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN COLDEN COMMON

Winchester City Council on behalf of Hampshire County Council proposes making a traffic regulation order as follows:-

<u>EFFECT OF ORDER:</u> To introduce waiting restrictions in Spring Lane and New Road, Colden Common Winchester, Hampshire

No Waiting at any time

Road Name	<u>Side</u>	Description
Spring Lane	Both	From the junction with Main Road to a point 36 metres west thereof.
New Road	Both	From the junction with Main Road to a point 24 metres west thereof.

<u>TITLE:</u> The order, if made will be known as "The Hampshire (Various Roads, Colden Common) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2006.
