- A proposal to revise the existing traffic regulation order in relation to waiting restrictions in Trafalgar Street, Winchester from the existing restriction of 'No Waiting 8;00am to 6:00pm Monday to Saturday' to 'No Waiting At Any Time' was advertised as shown on the attached schedules, plan and notice.
- The revision had been requested by Hampshire County Council and the Law Courts due to concerns over access.
- Five letters of objection, including one from a local Ward Member, were received to the proposal as advertised.
- After discussions with the Portfolio Holder and the local Ward Member concerned it
 has been agreed that the proposal is to be formally withdrawn. To this end the local
 Member has withdrawn their objection so that the proposal can be taken as a
 Portfolio Holders Decision.
