- It is proposed to revise the existing traffic regulation order in relation to waiting restrictions in Sparkford Road, Winchester from the existing restriction of 'No Waiting 8:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Saturday' to 'Goods Vehicles Only' for the newly constructed loading bay for the University of Winchester.
- The revision is being progressed as part of a planning application.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve the economy.

- The cost of the proposal is being funded by the developer. There will be no additional enforcement costs.
