SUMMARY

- Following the successful implementation of an Experimental Traffic Regulation Order to introduce access restrictions to Great Minster Street and associated two-way traffic on Market Lane a Committee resolution was passed to pursue making these restrictions permanent. See CAB2563(TP) 5 March 2014.
- The proposed changes were advertised on 9 July 2014. Notices were posted on street in the immediate vicinity of the proposed changes, published in the Mid Hants Observer, placed on the Council's website and held on deposit in the City Office reception. No responses were received.

- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.
- The cost of implementing the proposal is funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There are no enforcement costs to the Council as enforcement of the restrictions is carried out by the Police.





Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes making the undermentioned road traffic regulation orders:-

The City of Winchester (Central Area) Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 1984 (Variation No. 2) Order 2014

The effect of this order will be to remove the one way traffic flow direction in Market Lane Winchester and introduce a 6.0 ft width restriction in Great Minster Street Winchester. Details are as follows:

One Way Traffic in Market Lane, Winchester (that length of road which extends from its junction with Market Street to its junction with Paternoster Row) to be revoked and to introduce a 6' 0" width restriction in Great Minster Street, Winchester for its entire length with no exception for access.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE CITY OF WINCHESTER (CENTRAL AREA) TRAFFIC REGULATION (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 1984 (VARIATION NO.2) 2014

Winchester City Council acting on behalf of Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections under Sections 1,2 4,32,35,45,46,49,51 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act , and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:-

- In this order the "Principal Order " means "The City of Winchester (Central Area)
 Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 1984" as amended.
- 2. The Principal Order shall have effect in that the items in Schedule I to this order shall be removed from the Second Schedule of the Principal Order and the item in Schedule 2 of this order will be inserted as new Schedule Thirteen of the Principal Order
- 3. The following articles will be added to the Principle Order;
- "23.1 Save as Provided in Article 23.2 of this order no no person shall cause any vehicle exceeding 6ft in width to proceed in the Road Specified in the Thirteenth Schedule to this Order
- 23.2 Nothing in Article 23.1 of this Order shall apply to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the length of roads specified in Schedule Thirteen if the vehicle is being used is a police fire or ambulance vehicle in an emergency "
- is order may be cited as The City of Winchester (Central Area) Traffic Regulation
 (Consolidation) Order 1984 (Variation No. 2) Order 2014 shall come into operation
 on the day of 2014
- The Hampshire (Great Minster Street and Market Lane, Winchester) (Experimental)
 Traffic Regulation Order 2013 is hereby revoked on the coming into effect date of this order
