<u>TOPIC – TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER – A31 & A272 TEMPORARY SPEED</u> <u>LIMIT FOR SPECIAL EVENTS</u>

<u>SUMMARY</u>

- Changes to the existing A31 temporary speed limit order and an additional temporary speed limit order for the A272 was requested by Hampshire Constabulary for use when large special events are happening at the Matterley Estate. This is to enable 40 mph speed limits to be introduced and enforced to benefit road safety on these roads due to the increased volume of traffic and to accommodate vehicles entering and exiting the site safely.
- The proposed changes were advertised on 9 July 2014. Notices were posted on street in the immediate vicinity of the proposed changes, published in the Mid

Hants Observer, placed on the Council's website and held on deposit in the City Office reception. No responses were received.

- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.
- The cost of implementing the proposal is funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There are no enforcement costs for the Council.
- Copy of the plan showing the location and extent of the proposal is attached (Appendix 1).

- Copy of the advertised order is attached (Appendix 3).



1. The Hampshire (A31 Alresford Road, A31 Petersfield Road and A272 Petersfield Road, Winchester) (Temporary 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2014

The effect of this order will be to introduce a permanent 40 mile per hour speed limit on the A31 Alresford Road Winchester the A31 Petersfield Road Winchester and the A272 Petersfield Road Winchester.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE HAMPSHIRE (A31 ALRESFORD ROAD, A31 PETERSFIELD ROAD AND A272 PETERSFIELD ROAD, WINCHESTER) (TEMPORARY 40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2014

Winchester City Council acting on behalf of Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections under Sections 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order :-

- 1. Subject to the provisions of article 3 of this Order, no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in those lengths of road specified in Schedule I to this Order at speeds in excess of 40 miles per hour.
- 2. The provisions of article 1 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as may be indicated by traffic signs provided, with the agreement of the Director of Environment (HCC) and Chief Officer of Police, for the purpose of facilitating the passage on any road of any class of traffic in connection with the holding of an event likely to attract large volumes of traffic.
- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road traffic Regulations (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on the day of 2014 and may be sited as The Hampshire (A31 Alresford Road, A31 Petersfield Road and A272 Petersfield Road, Winchester) (Temporary 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2014.

SCHEDULE I

Roads to be subject to 40 miles per hour Speed limit

A31 ALRESFORD ROAD, WINCHESTER for a distance of approximately 6.5 kilometres between its junction with the A272 Petersfield Road and the roundabout junction of the B3047 Alresford Road (Lady Croft Farm Roundabout) [for identification purposes hatched blue on attached plan]

A31 PETERSFIELD ROAD, WINCHESTER for a distance of approximately 2.0 kilometres between the roundabout junction with the A272 Spitfire Link and its junction with the A272 Petersfield Road [for identification purposes hatched blue on attached plan]

A272 PETERSFIELD ROAD, WINCHESTER for a distance of approximately 5.0 kilometres between its junction with the A31 Alresford Road and a point 500 metres south-east of its junction with Rodfield Lane [for identification purposes hatched blue on attached plan]
