**SUMMARY**

- Changes to the existing traffic regulation order (TRO) in High Street, Southwick were requested by Hampshire County Council to facilitate the introduction of highway improvement works to construct a new mini-roundabout. This required the removal of the existing turning restrictions at this location and hence the revocation of the existing TRO.
- The proposed changes were advertised on 5 November 2014. Notices were posted on street in the immediate vicinity of the proposed changes, published in the Mid Hants Observer, placed on the Council's website and held on deposit in the City Office reception. No responses were received.

- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment.
- The cost of implementing the proposal is funded by HCC. There are no enforcement costs associated with the proposal.
- Copy of the plan showing the location and extent of the proposal is attached (Appendix 1).
- Copy of the proposed statement of reasons is attached (Appendix 2).
- Copy of the proposal notice is attached (Appendix 3).

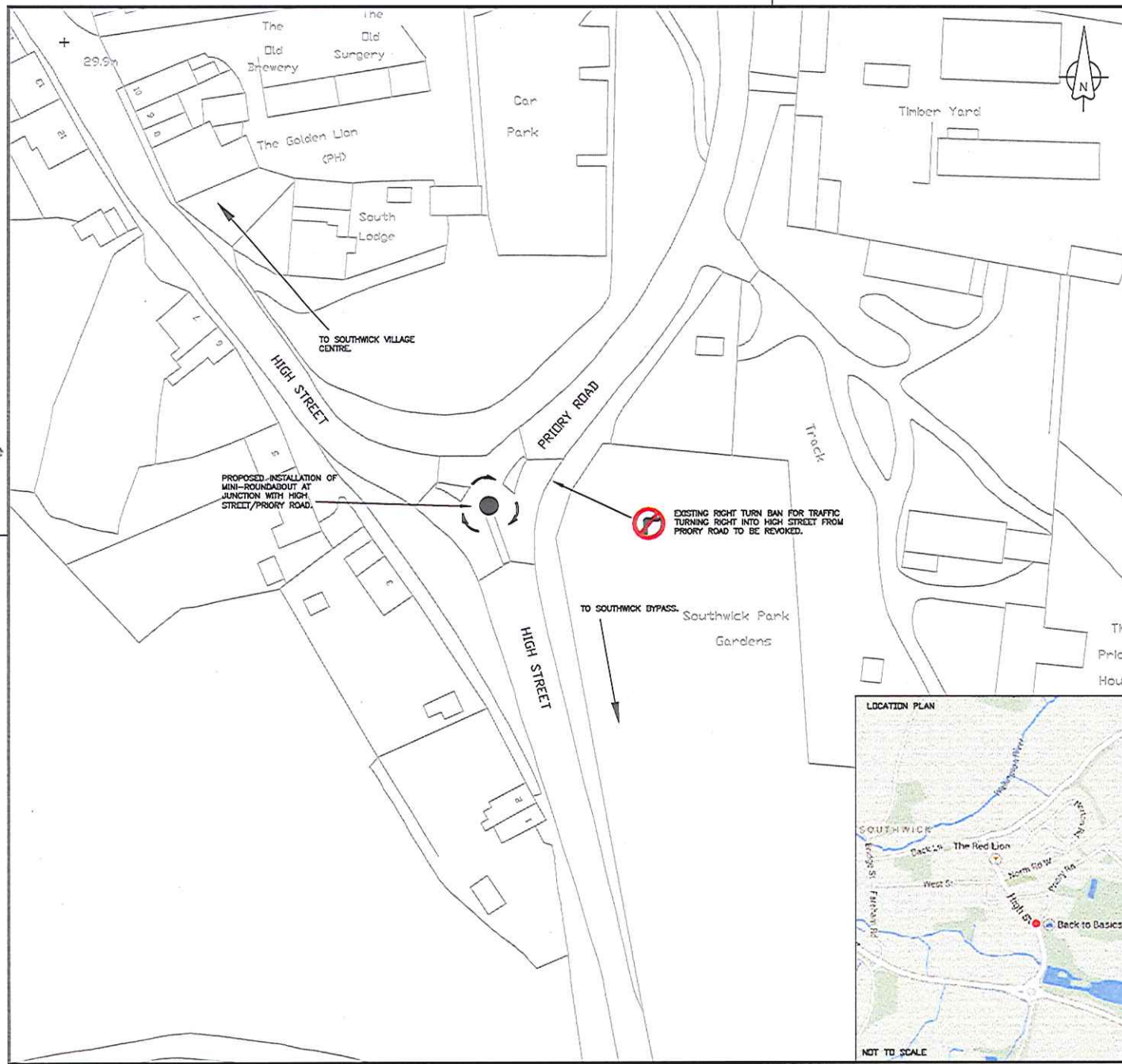

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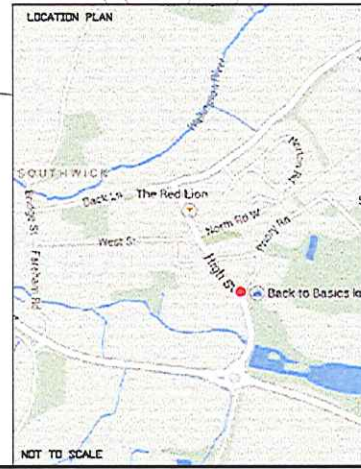

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**Southwick: High Street/Priory Road Junction – Revocation of Right Turn Ban**

**Statement of reasons:**

The current right turn ban at this location was installed at the request of Southwick Parish Council to discourage vehicles from HMS Dryad from driving through the village.

Following downsizing of HMS Dryad and discussion with the Parish it was agreed that the existing right turn ban was no longer required however in order to facilitate this the existing junction layout would need to be altered.

Following safety concerns about the existing layout if left as a T-junction, it was agreed that installation of a mini-roundabout would mitigate this. Therefore the right turn ban for vehicles turning right into High Street from Priory Road requires revocation in order to facilitate provision for a mini-roundabout at this junction.
