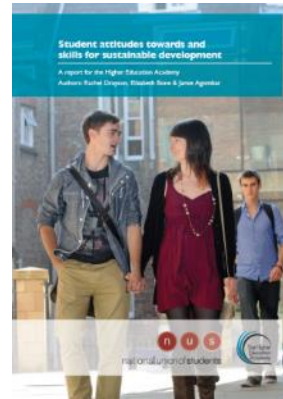

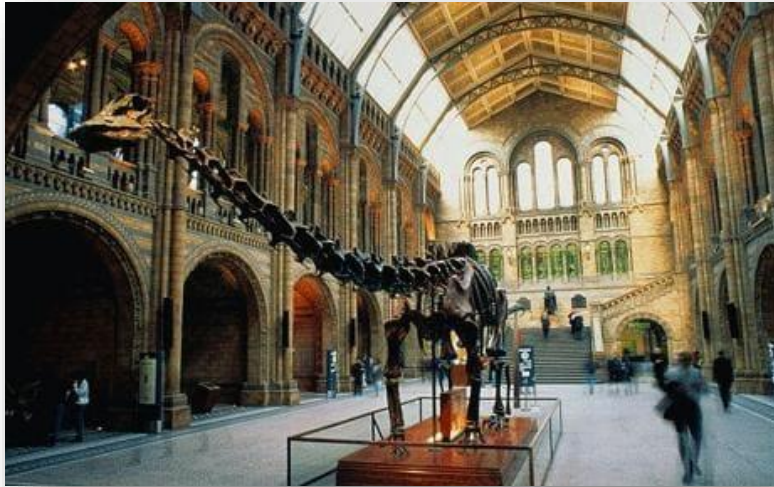

## Sustainable Local Food

Did you know?

- Sustainable local food is any food which is produced locally and eaten seasonally. It also involves supporting certified produce and eating less meat.
- Eating local food generally has a smaller carbon footprint than food which has come from a distance.
- Eating seasonally means less energy has been used in its production (no artificial lights for example).
- Food grown outdoors means less emissions as heated greenhouses haven't been used.
- Meat and dairy foods have a much bigger impact on the climate and environment than most grains, pulses, fruit and vegetables.

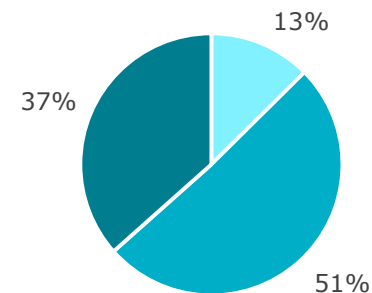
