Regulation 19 – Adoption Statement regarding Supplementary Planning Document

Oliver’s Battery Village Design Statement (VDS)

Winchester City Council has produced and adopted a Village Design Statement (VDS) for Oliver’s Battery which identifies design criteria against which planning applications in the area will be assessed.

The Oliver’s Battery VDS is a Supplementary Planning Document that supplements the Winchester District Local Plan Review (WDLPR 2006).

The document was adopted as supplementary to the Winchester District Local Plan Review by the Council on 15 July 2008, following the public consultation period held in November 2007.

The VDS incorporates within it a Statement of Public Consultation, which outlines the main issues raised in the consultation exercises and how the Council has addressed these issues in the final document. This Statement appears as Appendix B to the VDS, and fulfils the requirements of Regulation 18(4)(b) of the above regulations.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Oliver’s Battery VDS may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the Council’s decision to adopt it. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date of this notice.
