Sparsholt Village Design Statement (VDS)

Sparsholt Parish Council has produced a Village Design Statement (VDS) for Sparsholt which identifies design criteria against which planning applications in the area will be assessed.

Winchester City Council adopted the Sparsholt VDS as a Supplementary Planning Document to the Winchester District Local Plan on 5 September 2012 following a public consultation period held in 2007. The VDS incorporates within it a statement of public consultation, which outlines how the public was involved in the consultation on this document.
