The Alresford Drove needs improving on entry to the village, It is very difficult for equestrian access at times when cars are also traversing through this space (page 33 of the VDS). A scheme for improvement in this area could compliment the need for less disruptive access to the potential provision of the community space.

I also notice that on page 14 of the draft it is noted that St Margaret's Church is the 'sole place of worship', this raises a concern with me, that as the community has grown and continues to there isn't enough provision for worship locally to support other faiths and religions.
