



- Principal ridgelines and hills intercepting views from public viewpoints including footpaths.
- Landmarks (natural & manmade) seen from public Viewpoints within SDA area
- Areas of tree cover intercepting views from public viewpoints
- Railway line intercepts views from public viewpoints within SDA and provides views of SDA area to N & S of line.
- 30.0m contour and above features in principle ridgelines and hills within SDA area
- High point
- Views across river valley in both directions

- Panoramic views from public viewpoints across SDA area
- Existing network of public rights of way and lanes provide panoramic views in elevated locations within SDA area, mainly 30m and above
- Existing watercourses with corridors of mature tree cover intercepting views from public viewpoints
- Small irregular field pattern bordered by strong hedgerow network (Basemap), a key characteristic, restricts views of local prominence.
- Visually most sensitive
