#### **SUMMARY**

Following complaints from a resident and a request through the local MP it
was agreed to pursue the conversion of an existing advisory disabled bay in
Winnall Manor Road, Winchester to an enforceable one. Copies of the plan
showing the location of the proposal (Appendix 1), schedule and statement of
reasons (Appendix 2) are attached.

- The proposed changes were advertised on 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2012. The notice was published in the Mid Hants Observer, posted on site and placed on deposit. Copy of the notice is attached. (Appendix 3)
- No objections were received in response to the proposal as advertised.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management, road safety and the environment and for encouraging inclusive communities.

## **PROPOSED** DECISION

- 1. It is recommended to introduce 'Disabled Permit Holders Only' restrictions as advertised and detailed in the schedule attached. (Appendix 2)
- 2. That the Head of Legal Services be authorised to make the necessary order.

# REASON FOR THE DECISION AND OTHER ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

 All schemes included within the draft programme and other requests received have been assessed against criteria which include road safety, the concerns of the police, Ward Councillors and the Community.

## **RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS:**

- The cost of implementing the traffic regulation order and any associated signs and lining work is covered by the Traffic Management agreement with Hampshire County Council.
- Enforcement of any new restrictions will be carried out within existing budgets.

- Requests for consent to proceed to formal advertisement was sent to all local Ward Members, County Councillor, Police and WCC Parking Office Manager and duly confirmed.
