SUMMARY

- Following a review of the Council's policy of offering discounted Residents' permits for Low Emission Vehicles (LEV's) it was agreed to make a number of changes. A copy of the draft order and statement of reasons is attached as Appendix 1.
- The proposed changes were advertised on 2 May 2012. The notice was published in the Mid Hants Observer and placed on deposit. A copy of the notice is attached as Appendix 2.
- No objections were received in response to the proposal as advertised.

 The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve air quality and the environment by encouraging the uptake and use of Low Emission Vehicles.

PROPOSED DECISION

- 1) That discounts from the standard residents' parking permit fee for Low Emission vehicles (for the first permit issued) be introduced as follows:-
 - Electric vehicles or vehicles with emissions of 75g/km or less 75% discount:
 - b. Emissions from and including 76-90 g/km -50%.
- 2) That the Head of Legal Services be authorised to make the necessary order.

REASON FOR THE PROPOSED DECISION AND OTHER ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

The decision implements the proposal approved by Cabinet (Traffic and Parking) Committee (CAB2292(TP) refers) and no objections to the proposals were received.

RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS:

The cost of advertising and implementing the traffic regulation order is covered by the Traffic Management agreement with Hampshire County Council.

- In this order the "Principal Order " means "The Hampshire (Various Roads Winchester)

 2010 as amended.
- 2. The Principal Order shall have effect in that article 32 of the Principal Order shall now read as follows;

A discount for the appropriate fee as specified in Schedule 6 to this Order for the first permit issued in accordance with Article 19 and 20 shall be made for Vehicles with CO_2 emissions as follows; Electric vehicles or vehicles with emissions of 75g/km or less – 75% discount Emissions from and including 76-90 g/km – 50%

To encourage the take up and use of Low Emission Vehicles and therefore improve the air quality in Winchester.

Notice of Proposals of making of Various Road Traffic Regulation Orders Affecting the District of Winchester City Council

Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council proposes making the undermentioned road traffic regulation orders:-

3. The Hampshire (Various Roads Winchester) (Parking Places And Restriction Of Waiting) (Controlled Zone) (Consolidation) Order 2010 (Variation No. 6) Order 2012

The effect of this order will to change resident's discounts for parking permits for holders using low emission vehicles. Details are as follows:-

A discount for the appropriate fee as specified in the Order for the first permit issued shall be made for Vehicles with CO₂ emissions as follows;

Electric vehicles or vehicles with emissions of 75g/km or less – 75% discount

Emissions from and including 76-90 g/km – 50%

All current resident permit holders will be granted an additional year's renewal at the current discounted price to allow time to adjust to the proposed changes
