SUMMARY

- It is proposed to introduce 'No Waiting At Any Time' parking restrictions in Bere Road and Martin Avenue at their junctions with the B2150 Hambledon Road, Denmead and Hilda Gardens at its junction with Bere Road, Denmead to ensure unobstructed access.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Strategy in its attempt to provide a high quality environment and safe & strong communities.
- Formal notices were therefore advertised with no objections being received.
- The cost of the proposal will be funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There will be no additional enforcement costs.
