<u>TOPIC – PROPOSED REVISION TO TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER – KINGS ROAD, WINCHESTER</u>

PROCEDURAL INFORMATION

The Access to Information Procedure Rules – Part 4, Section 22 of the Council's Constitution provides for a decision to made by an individual member of Cabinet.

SUMMARY

- It is proposed to introduce waiting restrictions in Kings Road, Winchester of 'No Waiting 8:00am to 9:00am and 3:00pm to 4:00pm Monday to Friday' in the vicinity of the entrance to Kings School to ensure clear access for public service vehicles and emergency services access.
- The proposal is in keeping with the Corporate Priorities in its attempt to improve traffic management.
- An informal consultation was carried out with residents in Kings Road in the immediate vicinity of the proposals which raised no objection to the proposed introduction of 'No Waiting At Any Time' restrictions.
- Formal notices were therefore advertised which generated no objections, however, residents from adjacent streets subsequently became aware of the proposal and asked via a Ward Member that their views be included.

- An additional informal consultation was carried out including every property in Kings Road, Monarch Way and Nightingale Close.
- 12 letters of comment were subsequently received to the proposal as previously formally advertised. After further correspondence with the Ward Members it has been agreed to pursue a revised proposal taking into account the comments received.
- The revised proposal is to introduce 'No Waiting 8:00am to 9:00am and 3:00pm to 4:00pm Monday to Friday' to the same extent as originally advertised, including the bus stop clearways to the same restriction times. This revision can be pursued under the original proposal formally advertised as the changes are less onerous than those advertised.
- Should these restrictions be introduced it has been agreed that the situation is closely monitored and any remedial action expedited as necessary. All correspondents have been notified of this decision.
- The cost of the proposal will be funded through the Traffic Management Agency Agreement with Hampshire County Council. There will be no additional enforcement costs.
- A copy of a plan showing the revised proposal is attached.
- A copy of the revised proposed schedule and a statement of reasons are attached.
- A copy of the formal proposal notice is attached.
- Copies of informal consultation letters are attached.
- A summary of correspondence received is attached.

PROPOSED DECISION

It is recommended that;

• 'No Waiting 8:00am to 9:00am and 3:00pm to 4:00pm Monday to Friday' restrictions be introduced on the west side of Kings Road between a point 185.1 metres north of its junction with Romsey Road and a point 235.9 metres north of that junction – including the turning circle and on the east side of Kings Road between a point 183.0 metres north of its junction with Romsey Road and a point 225.6 metres north of that junction – including the turning circle and the City Secretary and Solicitor be authorized to make the necessary order.

<u>Proposed Introduction of No Waiting At Any Time and Bus Stop Clearway Restrictions</u> <u>- Kings Road, Winchester</u>

Further to the recent informal consultation regarding the proposed waiting restrictions in Kings Road, Winchester the comments received have been reviewed and it has been agreed with the local Councillors to proceed with the introduction of a revised scheme.

The majority of the comments received supported the need for waiting restrictions but were against them being for 'No waiting at any time Monday to Saturday'.

These comments have been acknowledged and consequently it is proposed to introduce restrictions for 'No waiting 8:00am to 9:00am and 3:00pm to 4:00pm Monday to Friday' to address the issue of access in the immediate vicinity of the school entrance whilst minimising the impact on residents and visitor parking in the evenings and at weekends.

These times will apply to both the single yellow lines and the bus stop clearways, with the extent of the restrictions to remain as indicated in the original proposal. A revised drawing is attached.

As these restrictions will be less onerous than those originally formally advertised the order can be progressed under the delegated powers of the relevant portfolio holder. The made order will be advertised again formally in due course, when there will be a further opportunity to comment on this process.

Once the restrictions are implemented the effect on parking in adjacent streets will be closely monitored and any changes will be expedited to address any resultant problems.
