TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ASHTON LANE, BISHOPS WALTHAM.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council has made an Order on traffic management grounds to allow for telecommunications piling and cabling works to be carried out as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED:

ASHTON LANE, BISHOPS WALTHAM from its junction with B2177 Winchester Road to its junction with Cross Lane.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the north-eastern point of the closure north-east via Ashton Lane, south-east via Beeches Hill, south-west via B3035 Lower Lane, north-west via B2177 Winchester Road **to the south-western point of the closure.**

From the south-western of the closure south-east via B2177 Winchester Road, north-east via B3035 Lower Lane, north-west via Beeches Hill, south-west via Ashton Lane **to the north-eastern point of the closure.**

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED:

None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE:

From and including the 17th August 2006 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above the closure is only likely to be for 1 week)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
