TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – FONTLEY ROAD, SEGENSWORTH.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council has made an Order on traffic management grounds to allow for bridge maintenance works to be carried out as follows:-

ROADS TO BE CLOSED:

FONTLEY ROAD, SEGENSWORTH for a distance of 100 metres either side of Fontley Road railway bridge.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the southern point of the closure west via Segensworth Road then south via Cartwright Drive then south-east via Southampton Road (A27) then north-east via Highlands Road then west via Kiln Road then north-west via Funtley Road and River Lane **to the northern point of the closure.**

From the northern point of the closure north via Fontley Road then east via River Lane then south east via Funtley Road then east via Kiln Lane then south west via Highlands Road then west via Southampton Road (A27) then north via Cartwright Drive then east via Segensworth Road **to the southern point of the closure.**

ORDERS TO BE SUSPENDED:

None.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE:

From and including the 23rd September 2006 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above the closure is only likely to be for 2 days)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
