TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – MILL LANE, WIDLEY.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council has made an Order to allow for bridge repair works to be carried out as follows:-

ROAD TO BE CLOSED – MILL LANE, WIDLEY between its junction with Potwell Lane to a point 250 metres south-east of that junction.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

From the north-western point of the closure north-east via Purbrook Heath Road, south via Widley Walk, west via B2177 Portsdown Hill Road, north via Mill Lane **to the south-eastern point of the closure.**

From the south-eastern point of the closure south via Mill Lane, east via B2177 Portsdown Hill Road, north via Widley Walk, south-west via Purbrook Heath Road **to the north-western point of the closure.**

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 27th May 2008 for a period of three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 3 weeks)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
