

**Notice of Making of Various Road Traffic Regulation Orders
Affecting the District of Winchester City Council**

On 23rd March 2010 Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council made the undermentioned road traffic regulation orders:-

1. **The Winchester City (Barfield Close and St Catherine's View) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2003 (Variation No. 2) Order 2010**

The effect of this order, proposals for which were advertised on 7th January 2010 will be to introduce a new Park and Ride Car park in Otterbourne Road Winchester, Hampshire known as the South Winchester Park and Ride. Discounted tickets may be available as follows:-

Annual Season Ticket	£552pa
Season Ticket - with 'Block-booked' 50% discount for employers booking & paying for at least 100 tickets per annum.	£345pa
Season Ticket - with 'Block-booked' 33% discount for employers booking & paying for between 50 and 100 tickets per annum.	£460pa
Term time only season ticket – for Winchester University. Based on published term time dates.	£225pa
Daily – Off-Peak ticket available for purchase after 10.30AM (Monday to Friday)	£2.00
pa – per annum	

the above orders will come into operation on the 19th April 2010

2. **THE WINCHESTER CITY (OFF STREET) PARKING PLACES
ORDER 2003
(VARIATION NO.2) ORDER 2010**

The effect of this order, proposals for which were advertised on 7th January 2010 will be to introduce resident discounts for parking in certain car parks. Details are as follows:-

- (i) A Resident of Winchester who currently qualifies for a parking permit will be entitled to a 30% discount on season tickets in pay and display car parks. A Resident Permit Holder who resides in Chesil Street shall be entitled to a 30% discount on the full season card price of Chesil Multi Storey Car park

(ii) A Resident of Winchester who may or may not qualify for a resident parking permit will be able to purchase a permit which will be valid Mondays to Fridays from 8 a.m to 9a.m and from 4pm to 6pm and between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on Saturdays for the following Fee £100 per annum at the following car parks; Chesil Surface Car Park; St Peters Car Park and the Cattle Market and Worthy lane Car park the above orders will come into operation on the 1st April 2010

3. **WINCHESTER CITY PARKING PLACES ORDER 2010**

The effect of this order, proposals for which were advertised on 7th January 2010 will be to introduce resident season tickets for Parking in Wickham Square. A full list of the properties eligible and a copy of a plan showing the area covered can be viewed at the City Offices. A small amendment to the original order deposited has been made in that it will be £10 for the first and second permit and £30 for the third

the above orders will come into operation on the 1st June 2010

Copies of the orders, maps showing the locations and a statement of reasons for each of the above orders and the orders to be varied may be inspected during usual office hours at the City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of any of the above orders or any of the provisions of the orders on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the date when the orders were made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
