

**Notice of Making of Various Road Traffic Regulation Orders  
Affecting the District of Winchester City Council**

On 1<sup>st</sup> December 2010 Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council made the undermentioned road traffic regulation order:-

**The Hampshire (Various Roads, Winchester) (Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) (NO.2) Order 2002 (Variation No.27) Order 2010.**

The effect of this order will be to introduce waiting restrictions in and around Olivers Battery Road North, Winchester. Details are as follows:-

the above order will come into operation on the 4<sup>th</sup> March 2011

A copy of the order, map showing the locations and a statement of reasons for the above order and the orders to be varied may be inspected during usual office hours at the City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of any of the above orders or any of the provisions of the orders on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within six weeks of the date when the orders were made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
