TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – VARIOUS ROADS UPHAM- 11/12 NO. 13

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Winchester City Council as agents for Hampshire County Council has made an order on traffic management grounds to allow for routine maintenance works to be undertaken as follows:

ROADS TO BE CLOSED:

1. **Alma Lane, Lower Upham**, between Mortimers Lane and the junction of Greenwood Lane
2. **Bigpath Lane, Upham**, between Belmore Lane and the junction of Church Street
3. **Blackdown, Upham**, between White Hill and the junction of Belmore Lane and to Lane End
4. **Manor Lane, Upham** between White Hill and the junction of Church Street
5. **Ower Farm Lane, Upham**, White Hill and the junction of Bigpath Lane
6. **Shoe Lane, Upham**, between White Hill to the junction of Church Street
7. **Stephens Castle Down Lane, Upham**, between Belmore Lane and the junction of Stakes Lane
8. **White Hill, Upham**, between Blackdown Lane and the junction of Shoe Lane

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES:

1. **Alma Lane** – via B2177 Winchester Road, Sciviers Lane, Durley Hall Lane.
2. **Bigpath Lane** – via Belmore Lane, Blackdown Lane, White Hill, Shoe Lane
3. **Blackdown** – via Belmore Lane Bigpath Lane, Shoe Lane, White Hill (no available diversion route for Lane End)
4. **Manor Lane** – via Shoe Lane, Church Street
5. **Ower farm Lane** – via White Hill, Shoe Lane, Bigpath Lane
6. **Shoe Lane** – via White Hill, Blackdown, Belmore Lane, Bigpath Lane
7. **Stephens Castle Down Lane** – via Belmore, Stakes Lane
8. **White Hill** – via White Hill, Blackdown, Belmore Lane, Bigpath Lane

Alternative routes will be signposted at the time of closure. Individual road closures in the same area will be implemented consecutively and not simultaneously.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE:

From 1st November 2011 for a period of 12 months or until completion of the works.

Each road is only expected to be closed for two separate periods of approximately 1 week each.

With the exception of any emergency works, advance warning signs will be displayed approximately 2 weeks in advance of any road closure being enforced.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
