

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1990 - SECTION 257
AND PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14

THE WINCHESTER CITY (PARISH OF MICHELDEVER)
(PART OF FOOTPATH NO. 23)
PUBLIC PATH ORDER 2011

On 6 January 2012, Winchester City Council confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to stop up the length of the public footpath which runs for a total of 86 metres from Andover Road in a northerly direction to the rear of 12 Brunel Close from grid reference SU 5169 4284 to SU 5168 4290 and to create an alternative footpath which runs for a total of 98 metres from Andover Road in a northerly direction to the rear of 9 Brunel Close from grid reference SU 5165 4284 to SU 5169 4290 as shown on the Order map.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at the offices of Winchester City Council, City Offices, Colebrook Street, Winchester during usual office hours. Copies of the map and the Order may be bought there at the price of £2.00.

This Order comes into force on the date on which Winchester City Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the Order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of those purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
