

**Notice of Proposals of making of Various Road Traffic Regulation Orders  
Affecting the District of Winchester City Council**

Winchester City Council proposes making the undermentioned road traffic regulation order:-

**Winchester City (Off Street) Parking Places Alresford (No.2) Order 2012.**

The effect of this order will be to introduce Car Parking charges at Arlebury Park Car Park. Details are as follows:-

**Additional Parking Permits:**

A rebate on the purchase of multiple season tickets may be available according to capacity.

The level of rebate shall be determined by the Head of Access and Infrastructure.

Permits will also be issued to the New Alresford Town Council for staff parking at a cost of £0.00 (for this car park only)

In addition to the above an annual season ticket will be available to purchase from the Council at a cost of £275 (the car park will be included within the Group F Season Tickets) Group F Season Tickets are eligible for a discount for vehicles with CO<sub>2</sub> emissions as follows; Electric Vehicles and vehicles with Emissions of 75g/km or less – 75% discount; Emissions from and including 76 -90 g/km – 50%

Parking will not be available on certain times as advertised by notice on site
