Proposal: Replacement of windows at ground floor and first floor to the rear of the property and erection of new bootroom to replace existing lean-to

Proposal: Proposed roofing repairs; replacement of worn out rock asphalt waterproofing to a number of the valley and parapet gutters, together with general maintenance of the roofs, flashings and the like, repairs to the gutter timbers and supports including strengthening to some of the roof trusses to the west roof and main roof which have been affected by decay, improvements to the drainage of the west roof at downpipes rwp03 and rwp04 (plan 2478-01) large area of the main upper roofs to the central block as well as the west roof drains to these outlets, add sumps to the parapet gutter at each of these downpipe locations (plan 2478-07) also add overflows from the sumps as shown on the drawing as a safeguard against future flooding (2478-WE1) strengthening of the decayed ends of roof trusses, the south ends of two, or possibly three of the roof trusses supporting the south roof at the west end of the building and one area of the main roof have been badly affected by decay and to strengthen these in a similar manner to that used in the past in the building (using steel plates and shoes)
