PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From and including the 4th August 2008 for three months or until completion of the works whichever is sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 3 weeks)

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
