

#### BACKGROUND TO WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL HOUSING

- 5000 homes (including 700 sheltered flats)
- £28m Income from Rents each year
- £14m spend on maintaining homes and estates
- Arrears = 1%
- Tenant Satisfaction = 91%
- Empty Properties relet time = 14 days
- All within the top 25% of social landlords nationally!
  Over 1700 in housing need!

#### WHAT'S BEEN GOING ON SINCE THE LAST CONFERENCE?

- Pay to Stay/High Value Sales "shelved"?
- No News on ending Secure Tenancies
- 100 New Homes built, 100 more on site,
- 89 lost through "Right to Buy"!
- All Homes Now meet "Decent Homes Standard"
- Plans in place to keep them "Decent"!
- Improved Tenant Satisfaction
- New Gas Contractor
