## **Application to Vote by Post**

Dear Elector

Please find enclosed the application form to vote by post. Please note this is not a registration form and you will need to be registered before we process this form. You can use this form to apply to vote by post for a particular election, for a set period of time or for all future polls. Postal votes can be sent to addresses in the UK and abroad.

### **How do I apply to vote by post?**

Fill in the postal vote application form. Make sure to complete all sections of the form and supply your date of birth and signature. This is a requirement as you will need to provide this when you receive your postal vote form in order to prevent fraud. If you are unable to sign this form, please contact us. Once complete, return your form to us using our Freepost address or by scanning this in an email to us.

### **What happens after I've returned this form?**

Once your postal vote is in place, you will no longer be able to vote in person at an election. When an election is going to be held, your ballot paper will be sent to you in the post. Make sure you return your postal vote so that it arrives by the close of poll, otherwise it will not be counted.

### **Privacy Statement**

We will only use the information you give us for electoral purposes. We will look after personal information securely and we will follow the Data Protection legislation. We will not give personal information about you or any personal information you may provide on other people to anyone else or another organisation unless we have to by law.

The lawful basis to collect the information in this form is that it is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest and exercise of official authority as vested in the Electoral Registration Officer as set out in Representation of the People Act 1983 and associated regulations. The Electoral Registration Officer is the Data Controller.
