

# LOCAL PLAN 2036 WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL

## Local Plan Launch

The Council agreed at its Cabinet on 18 July to launch preparation of a new local plan.

The Council has to prepare a new local plan, following adoption of local plan part 2 last year and in light of changes to National Planning Guidance.

The Council therefore seeks your views on the scope and content of the local plan and has set up an on-line consultation at [www.winchester.gov.uk/Winchester-lp-launch](http://www.winchester.gov.uk/Winchester-lp-launch), this asks some key questions that will help us to shape the new local plan. The consultation will run from Tuesday 24 July 2018 until midday Friday 21 September 2018. At this stage, there are no documents to comment on, but your ideas and suggestions are welcome as to what the local plan should include. Paper copies of the consultation questions have been left with Parish Councils and are available in local libraries. Responses will be reported to the Council's Cabinet (Local Plan) Committee in due course.

## Review of Statement of Community Involvement

The Council adopted its Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) a number of years ago, with the preparation of a new local plan about to commence, now is a good time for this to be updated.

## Strategic Housing and Economic Land Availability Assessment (SHELAA)

In the past the Council has prepared a SHLAA Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment, planning guidance advises to broaden this to include land for economic purposes – hence SHELAA. This will comprise a register of potentially available and deliverable sites for consideration through the Local Plan process. During January 2018 the Council issued a Call for Sites. Over 200 submissions have been received and are currently being assessed. The intention is to publish the SHELAA later in the year.

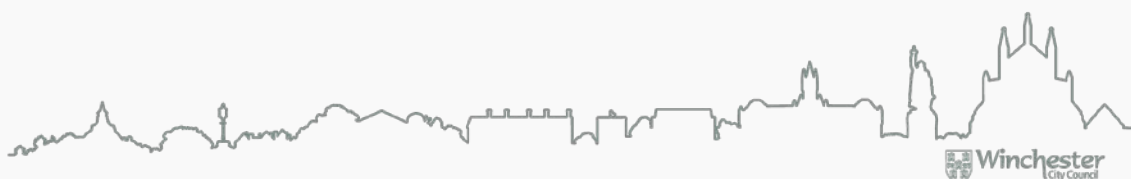
