The family fall within the planning definition of Gypsy/Traveller as set out in the PPTS. Tom Buckley undertakes landscaping work which includes driveways and footpaths. He can be away from the site for a month at a time as he leaflets drops areas to advertise his services as well as placing boards outside properties where he has undertaken work. The Appellant is currently away travelling for work.</li> <li>The LPA reply upon a previous inspector's appeal decision having regard to the appeal site and</li> </ul>						
adjoining land on the basis that the inspector found in her opinion that the land was located in an unsustainable location and that the use of the site would be harmful to character and appearance. However, it is inevitable that Gypsy/Traveller sites will be located in rural area away from villages, as indeed are other such sites in Winchester City Council area. Clearly the use of the appeal site causes						

	some harm to the character and appearance of the area, but it is not considered that this is so harm to warrant the dismissal of this appeal. The LPA refer to their site allocation document and that they have identified a 5-year supply of pitche to meet the need for Gypsy/Traveller pitches. The appellant and his family are part of the need. Whe Council officers have referred to sites being available the appellant has said could they go to such sit however they have been advised that the sites are not available.	es en
