What will we be doing on site over the next period

Over the next month we will be concentrating on the completion of our site set up and commencing our main construction works:

- Establishment of our main office, site and welfare accommodation
- Provision of safe access and egress to and from the work areas from the Depot
- Establishment of our material and plant storage areas
- Commencement of the top soil stripping
- Excavation to formation of the building footprint
- Constructing the temporary diversion footpath to the University Sports Track. Please note that the completion of these paths will now not be until 5th April. This has been delayed because some extra tree protection works are required. We appreciate your patience on this matter.
