## **Additional Comments**

Planting at edges only, remove Flowerbed Island to give max area for play. Keep tables to edge, would prefer no tables, kids seats not necessary. No change fine, leaves must be removed.

Prefer path as helpful for kids after removing slide and swing

Children friendly things that don't require ongoing maintenance

Child loves the swing so we would use it less. Think there is space to have a small swing to make it family friendly for all.

Like idea of picnic and other seating and also thinking of wildlife. Shame that play area will be lost but understand costs and maintenance.

Maybe add a shaded area like wood . Would be used more often to sit and relax. What about a rubber crumb path for softness.

Remove stepping stones, tables and seats as unnecessary as could encourage unsavoury behaviour. Path quite nice to divide areas off. More benches to sit on under copper beech. Avington, Braemore, Atlantic do not have a garden. People in houses have back gardens!

Path ideal for wheelchairs, no need for pebble stepping stones. Picnic tables unnecessary would encourage youths to gather. Seating round copper beech will always be used. Needs to cater more for adults as many play areas in the area. Peace and calm for adults to relax is necessary. Please adjust times of entry, youths come early on their way to school and late at night. We don't have a back garden so essential for us.

No tables and chairs instead another bench seat near the bed. No stepping stones

Move picnic table in centre to table by top left seat if picnic tables are needed? Prefer just seating for residents. Planter not needed. Children's play seats not needed. Leave space for kids to run around maintenance must include leaf clearance and shrub bed cutting and clearance

Seating is important. Leaf clearance on regular basis vital. Grass is now only mown and requires replacement. No picnic tables please.

Not happy about picnic tables, issue with litter and late night drinking. Maintenance is an important concern as currently residents clear all litter and leaves.

Feel very strongly that the area should still include some play equipment even if just some swings. Should be a space suitable and relevant for all ages. There are a couple of residents who have young children; this is just a space for adults on these designs.
