What has happened?

The construction of the pools is now well underway with works progressing over the last month on the main pool, teaching pool, hydrotherapy pool, and the pit that supports the installation of the buildings lift. The works have included the installation of reinforcing, steel and shutters and the placing of concrete. A large percentage of the pad found **very happy** in support the structural steel frame which is due to start on site later this summer. We have now completed the import of chalk which is being used to raise the building footprint to protect the building from pos

The next activities on site are:


- Completion of the building foundations
