



SITE NOTICE STATING ENFORCEMENT NOTICE SERVED

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

Winchester City Council has served an ENFORCEMENT NOTICE in respect of land at Lower Paddock, Bent Lane, Hambledon, Hampshire PO7 4QP (the Land) shown edged red on the attached plan. The notice takes effect on the **16 June 2020** unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

The Enforcement Notice relates to the material change of use of the Land to a residential caravan site for gypsies and travellers (which includes creation of an access and engineering works to create a hardstanding) and requires you to:

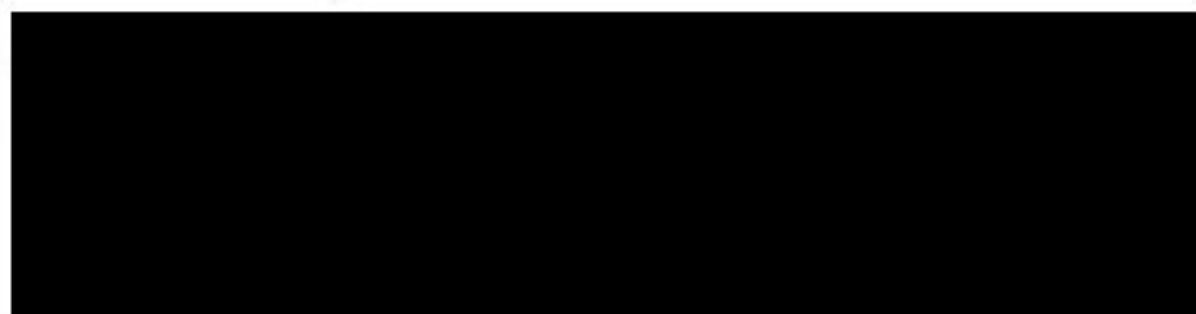
- i. Cease the use of the Land as a caravan site for gypsies and travellers.
- ii. Remove the hardstanding and access and take the material off the site.
- iii. Reinstate the field to the condition it was in before the development commenced.
- iv. Replace the hedgerow which was removed to create the access.
