

Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 Adoption of Supplementary Planning Document (Regulation 14) Crawley Village Design Statement (VDS) Adoption Statement

A Village Design Statement (VDS) has been produced for the Parish of Crawley which identifies design criteria against which planning applications in the Parish will be assessed. The Crawley VDS (2001) has been revoked and replaced.

Winchester City Council adopted the Crawley VDS as a Supplementary Planning Document to the Winchester District Local Plan on 7th December 2020 following a public consultation period in spring 2020. Modifications made following these consultations can be found in the report to Cabinet on 7th December 2020 (DD20). The VDS incorporates within it a statement of public consultation, which outlines how the public was involved in the consultation on this document.
