

What has happened?

All Covid-19 social distancing guidelines continue to be fully adhered to and are standard practice as we continue to progress well on site.

The project's external works are taking shape with hard landscaping around the main building, retaining walls, access roads, and car parking bays, all now well underway. The new roundabout construction on Bar End Road and associated works to pathways is now complete, and the traffic management has been removed.

Internally our supply chain partners continue to progress well. As the internal walls near completion, the mechanical and electrical works are following on and going well. The ceilings to the sports hall and pool areas are nearing completion.

Ceramic tiling is well underway in the main pool area, and tiling has been completed to the learner pool. The moveable floor to the learner pool is also currently being installed. Construction of the gym floor has started, and decoration works throughout the building are ongoing. The impressive equipment for the clip and climb area has been installed.

What happens next?

Over the coming weeks we will be focusing on:

- The continued installation of the mechanical & electrical elements.
- Continuation of ceramic tiling to hydrotherapy & main pool areas.
- Construction of bin and cycle stores.
- Progression of hard landscaping & soft landscaping.
- Decoration of internal areas including dance studios.
- Installation of the moveable floor to the learner & main pools.
- Soft & hard flooring finishes.

We are eager to restart this programme in its current format as soon as it is safe to do so and is looking likely to recommence in the new year.
