On a more practical note -- I hope all is working out ok for you both at Richard's.

I did mention to you that before we left to come back here that I had had the Electric and Gas meters read Your mum brought my mail out from England with her and that included these accounts.

The accounts covered the period up to 22nd April (ie it includes a short period when I was living at no 2 after my return from Sri Lanka)

The Gas bill for the period was £456.18

The Electric bill for that period was 226.28

The bill for water and sewage (on past use for the winter period when I am always in Spain is £20 per month-- I only get an updated statement once a year

in December each year -- I would guess that the house being occupied and water etc being used would say double it per month -- ie .say £40 per monthsay, £120 for the 3 three month period)

That comes to £802

Could I suggest that the cost to you is £750 for your stay at No. 2 , bearing in mind that you were not there after 10th April.
