Thank you for meeting me earlier today to inspect the various matters at the above site.

Based on our discussions and my observations I am satisfied that the mobile home is currently being used as ancillary accommodation to the main dwelling and does not represent a breach of planning control. I was also pleased to note the summerhouse has now been moved back within the curtilage of the dwelling and is no longer a breach of planning control. Turning to the extension to the outbuilding I observed it is currently being used for incidental purposes as a gym/exercise area and on this basis the Council does not intend to take any further action.

In light of the above, the enforcement investigation has now been closed. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.
