
The City of Winchester & The University of Southampton: A broader and deeper relationship...

- We seek new places and spaces for the strategic development of our university to grow the scope, scale and impact of our research, enterprise and education work.
- Our proposal is to collaborate with WCC and the community on a reimagined University of Southampton presence in the city - larger and of greater impact and value – through developing our art school and establishing a new, multi-disciplinary facility on the river Park Site.
- Such developments would support sector skills gaps and business improvement in the Winchester and wider region and unlock developing research and innovation potential in areas of significance to the region and the world.
- The developments would be 'porous', public-facing and accessible. They would be shaped by our civic role, to be of service to our host communities, helping transform the cultural offer, the offer to young people, and the vitality of the city economy.


The University is committed to making a greater contribution to the civic life of the city: Developing our art school and establishing a new facility on the River Park site would deliver many benefits, including:
