

MAIN ENTRANCE & PLAZA

- Park Avenue entrance designed in a simple, natural way in keeping with the informal character of the area. New paving, landscaped seating area
- Plaza style multi-functional space with outdoor area for events, water fountains for play, seating & permanent cafe/toilet building
- New bench seating to face both ways to the pathway
- Children's paddling area by side of river

PLAY & SKATE

- Develop Skatepark hub/equipment store with existing Skatepark users
- Upgraded play space with equipment to encourage exploration & play for young & older children
- Repaint Banana Bridge as an existing feature within the Park

SPORTS & FITNESS

Outdoor fitness & exercise equipment with multi-functional area for all-weather classes

PITCHES & PICNICS

- (9) Kickabout area with goal post
- New multi-use perimeter path with discrete distance markers and appropriate surfacing for all-weather conditions
- Resurface with new seating & sympathetic artwork to form an attractive place within the Park
- Potential new bridge associated with the perimeter path to increase access around the Park
- Nun's Walk northern entrance tidied up/redesigned in a simple way
- Improve Nuns Road entrance with resurfacing & by replacing the existing vehicle barriers with more attractive design
- Resurface the main linear path through the Park

QUIET & WILDLIFE

- Improve Winnall Moors Nature Reserve West Entrance in a low-key sympathetic way
- Dipping platforms along riverbank to encourage & facilitate engagement with the aquatic environment (net dipping)
- Quieter areas with biodiverse planting & features such as natural shelters to encourage wildlife
