WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL GRANTS

Winchester City Council's grant funding programme supports voluntary and not-for-profit groups and organisations in the district that can clearly demonstrate how their services and projects help deliver a cohesive, sustainable, resilient community.

There are two schemes that communities can apply for.

THE SMALL GRANT SCHEME provides one-off grants to local voluntary/not-for -profit groups and organisations, which are quick and easy to apply for. Charities, community groups and other not-for-profit organisations can apply for grants of up to £500 for one-off expenditure on projects, equipment and other items to help organisations to do more, reach more people, or provide better services. They can apply at any time, with decisions made every three months. Visit winchester.gov.uk/small-grant-scheme.

CROWDFUND WINCHESTER offers up to £4,000 to match an equivalent amount donated by others on our crowdfunding platform. This is open to charitable organisations and businesses within the Winchester district that are implementing change, tackling the climate emergency or supporting our communities.
